

Rural Municipality of Wellington No. 97

BYLAW NO. 2-2018

A BYLAW TO RECOVER FIRE FIGHTING EXPENDITURES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Wellington No. 97 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a. "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b. "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
 - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Wellington No. 97.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who received the service in accordance with the rates contained within the most recent Rescue and Fire Protection Service Agreements in effect.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this Bylaw any amount which remains unpaid:
 - a. at the end of the calendar year or 30 days after the person has been invoiced for the said services, whichever is earlier.
4. Bylaw No. 1-2012 is hereby repealed.
