

BYLAW #79-2

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE SITUATING OF BUILDINGS
IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WELLINGTON NO. 97

The council of the Rural Municipality of Wellington No. 97
in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows: -

1. In this bylaw:

"road" means any road allowance within the
Rural Municipality of Wellington No. 97
other than:

- (i) a private road;
- (ii) a provincial highway;
- (iii) a road or highway within the
following hamlets, namely:

Cedoux
Colfax
Tyvan

- 2. No building shall be situated a distance of less than
150 feet from the centre line of any road.
- 3. No building shall be situated a distance of less than
300 feet from an intersection of roads.
- 4. This bylaw does not apply with respect to buildings
situated prior to the passing of the bylaw.
- 5. Every person who causes a building to be situated in
contravention of this bylaw shall be guilty of an
offence and liable on summary conviction to the pen-
alties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the
Rural Municipality of Wellington No. 97.
