In 2016 when the RM purchased the John Deere 772 GP grader, Brandt service mileage was not charged for the first year of owning the machine. The following year Brandt made a change to this service increasing to five years. Over the time the RM has owned the grader a total of \$2,923.82 has been charged for service mileage. Mr. Lakeman and Mr. Brand offered the RM a credit of \$2,000.00 and 5 pails of arctic guard oil (taken off of this credit) to resolve the charges of service mileage, to which Council

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accepted. Mr. Lakeman also brought a quote for a new 2021 870 GP John Deere Grader.
