



Building Permits Required

Always apply for a Building Permit before proceeding with a building project. **Here is why:**

The Construction Codes Act outlines the **responsibilities** of the building owners, municipalities, building officials and construction industry regarding construction standards in Saskatchewan.

Applying for a Building Permit initiates a **Plan Review**, assessing your design against the requirements under *The Construction Codes Act*.

This can result in significant **time and money savings** for the building owner, compared to having to go back and make changes after construction has started.

If your project is **exempt** from requiring a Building Permit, it will be determined during the review process.

How to apply for a permit:

First, apply for a Development permit from **the RM of Wellington**. After that is approved, apply for a Building Permit from **the RM of Wellington**.

The RM of Wellington collects permit fee and issues the Building Permit and Plan Review.

Call your building official for inspections as outlined in Permit's Plan Review.
