The purpose of the Special Meeting of Council is to discuss the 2025 Budget and Capital Projects as well as development permits, clay for ratepayers, Cedoux dugout cleanup and seasonal employee wages.

90/25	2025 Budget	Council worked through and made changes to the preliminary budget that was prepared by the Administrator. Council will take some time to look over the changes and will meet again to discuss before the final 2025 Budget is approved.		
91/25	2025 Capital Budget	Council will be replacing the bridge decking on the bridge at WSW 27-12-15 W2 as well as a few smaller culvert projects. The RM is also working to complete the community dugout project in Cedoux. Some equipment purchases have already been made this year. These projects and purchases will make up the RM's 2025 Capital budget. These projects may be curtailed if other emergent situations present themselves.		
92/25	Development Permit Chinski	GAUBE: that the Council for the R.M. of Wellington approve the development permit from Leo Chinski for the move of a shed onto his lots in Cedoux; however, the building will require a permit as per Building Bylaw 2023-01.		
93/25	Development Permit Mainil	LEGUEE: that the Council for the R.M. of Wellington approve the development permit from Branden Mainil to build a new house and attached garage at SE 11-10-15 W2 and that a Building Permit will be required as per Building Bylaw 2023-01.	d.	
94/25	Clay for use by ratepayers	KYRYLCHUK: that R.M. of Wellington No. 97 ratepayers be able to purchase clay from the R.M. at a cost of \$10 a yard and that, if a ratepayer decides to purchase clay, that RM employees will load the cla with the RM owned backhoe at a rate of \$150 per hour with a ½ hour minimum charge.		

95/25 Seasonal Employee Salary	BORYS: that the hourly wage for Cory Riess be raised to his start date of March 31, 2025.) \$28 effective Carried.
