- 122/25 **Lead Hand Report** Assistant Lead Hand Kolin Piwarski reported on the previous month's repairs to equipment and road maintenance activities.
- 123/25 **Administrator Report** Administrator Michelle Klein gave a verbal report of happenings within the RM as well as office duties during the month of June.
- 124/25 **Reeve/Councillor Reports** Each Councillor delivered their verbal report regarding issues experienced over the last month with respect to their individual divisions.
- 125/25 **Additional Culvert Installation** BORYS: that, to improve the movement of water, a 24" culvert be installed at WNW 32-10-14 W2 for a total of 5 runs of culvert at the site.

- 126/25 **Road Allowance Discussion** Council discussed the road allowance between Section 19 & 20 12-15-W2. The Lead Hand and Reeve will go out to determine a plan for next steps. This will be discussed at the next Regular meeting of Council.

- 127/25 **Bin Yard Development** GAUBE: that the development request submitted for the development of a bin yard at the NNW of 09-12-13 W2 be approved and furthermore that Council acknowledges the bin yard will be within the 150-foot setbacks from the centre of the road but, because of the tree line currently at the site, the development will not pose an issue with snow build-up along the road.
