- 60/26 **Lead Hand Report** Lead Hand Don Stein gave a verbal report on the previous month's repairs to equipment and road maintenance activities.
- 61/26 **Reeve/Councillor Reports** Each Councillor present delivered their report regarding issues experienced over the last month with respect to their individual divisions.
- 62/26 **Administrator Report** KOT: that the Administrator report be accepted as presented.
 Carried.
- 63/26 **Backhoe Tire Quote** LEGUEE: that the quote from Quality Tire for \$4,609.50 for the purchase of new backhoe tires be accepted.
 Carried.

- 64/26 **Delegate – Pearl Gawel** Ms. Gawel came to the meeting to discuss some history of Cedoux as well as pass along historical information which is to be kept at the RM office in Cedoux.

- 65/26 **Delegate – Marshall Bakken - UFA** Mr. Bakken came to the meeting to discuss different fuel options and pricing with the RM.

- 66/26 **Culvert Replacement** BORYS: that the culverts at NNE 09-10-13 W2 be replaced with 3 runs of 36 inch culverts and that the work be completed by VOS Industries.

- 67/26 **Box Bridge Replacement** GAUBE: that the box bridge at NNW 07-10-13 W2 be replaced with 3 runs of 36-inch culverts and that the work be completed by VOS Industries.
Carried.
Councillor Leguee returned to Council chambers.
- 68/26 **Trenching on or near RM road allowance** GAUBE: that a letter be sent to the owner of the south ½ 18-12-13 W2 stating that Council is concerned that the trenching is too close to the RM road allowance and that the trench may in fact be within the road allowance. The letter will include a notice that if the trench is within the road allowance, they will be expected to fill it in and landscape the ditch. The letter is to also include a statement regarding the filling of sprayer trailers which is not to be done on or along the RM roads.

- 69/26 **Culvert Order** LEGUEE: that the quote from Titan Environmental for culverts be accepted at a cost of \$53,484.37.

- 70/26 **Warranty and General Repairs to 870GP** BORYS: that the quote for warranty items and repairs to the 2021 870GP be approved.

- 71/26 **2025 Dust Control Cost Share** LEGUEE: that, for 2026, the RM of Wellington No. 97 cover 30% of all dust control applications within the RM and whereas, the RM has full control of maintenance on dust control spots and that if a ratepayer does not let the RM maintain the spot, then no dust control will applied.

- 73/26 **Development Permit SW 28-10-14 W2** BORYS: That the Development Permit submitted by Scott Pohl for the development a Double Car Garage located on SW 28-10-14 W2 be approved and that a building permit be applied for as per clause 4(a) of Building Bylaw 23-01.
